Answer these five questions before you come to the HU for education, work or a place to study.



**1** Do you have complaints that may be caused by the corona virus?  
*Nasal cold, cough, sneezing, loss of smell / taste, shortness of breath, fever*

**2** Do you have a roommate with corona?

**3** Do you have a roommate with serious complaints that fit with corona?  
*Such as fever or shortness of breath*

**4** Have you been in close contact with someone with corona?  
*Minimum of 15 minutes within 1.5 meter*

## STAY AT HOME

Request a test from the GGD.

> Stay at home while waiting for the results.

- Does the test show that you have corona?
- Test result negative? Go to question 2.

> Do you have a fever and / or shortness of breath? Then your housemates should also stay at home.

## STAY AT HOME

If you develop complaints: get tested by the GGD.

## STAY AT HOME

> Your housemate must be tested at the GGD.

> As soon as you also develop complaints: get tested by the GGD. All housemates stay at home until the results of the corona test of the sick housemate is known.

## THE GGD RECOMMENDS: STAY AT HOME

If you develop complaints: get tested by the GGD.

## STAY AT HOME

You are not allowed to come to university for 10 days after your return. If you develop complaints: get tested by the GGD.

## STUDY AND WORK FROM HOME

- Students inform their study advisor.
- Employees inform their manager.

## WHAT TO DO IN CASE OF CONTAMINATION?

If you have corona, your roommates / family members should also be quarantined at home, as well as your close contacts. The GGD gives instructions about this together with the test result.
