

Introduction to EU Social law:

In this course students will be made familiar with the impact of EU law on social and labor law of the EU Member States. Areas such as transfers of undertakings, anti-discrimination, working time, posting of workers etc. have become increasingly influenced by harmonization at EU level in the last decades. This course will guide students through the most important pieces of EU legislation in the field of social and labor law and their practical legal implications in national law. In addition, the case law of the ECJ on these topics will be studied extensively. After completion of the course students will be able to assess on their own the consequences of EU social law for national social law in a given case.
